PRIOR TO INSTALLATION

Read the manual prior to installation. Technical knowledge is necessary for installation. The place of installation must be free of moisture and away from heat sources. Please ensure that the correct tools are using during the installation to avoid damage to the vehicle or product. Connects2 can not be held responsible for the installation of this product.

INSTALLATION GUIDE

1. Use a pair of release keys to release the OEM head unit (Fig. 1). Remove and disconnect the unit.

2. Remove the screws holding the metal cage in position (Fig. 2) and remove the cage (Fig. 3)

3. Use a screwdriver to remove the two screws circled (Fig. 4) and pull out the OEM air vent panel (Fig. 5)

4. Install the OEM switch bar into the fascia panel included in the kit (Fig. 6/Fig. 7)

5. Remove the two screws at the bottom of the dash cavity and place the air vent housing including in the kit into the cavity (Fig. 8)

6. Mount the metal brackets to the right and left sides of the aftermarket stereo (Fig. 9). Then install the stereo and the air vent housing into the dashboard (Fig. 10).

NB: Make all wiring connections to the stereo before screwing it into place. Test stereo for correct operation before continuing

7. Mount the five metal clips to the back of the fascia panel at the circled locations (Fig. 11).

8. Push the fascia panel into the dash, making sure to reconnect the OEM switch bar to the vehicle. The installation is now complete. (Fig. 12)

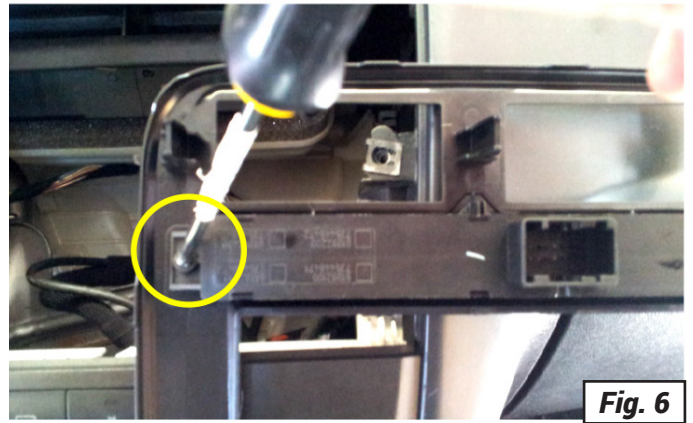

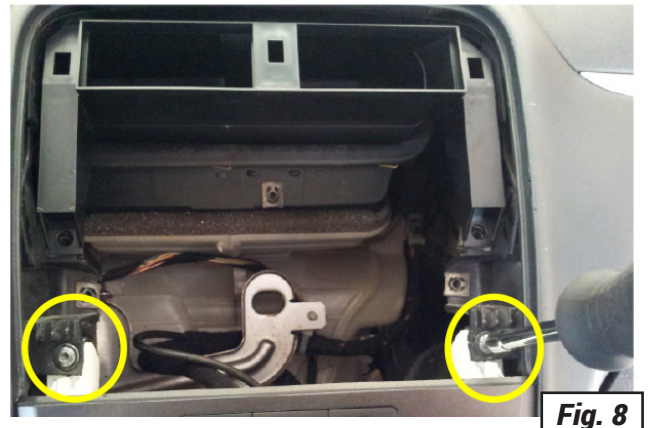

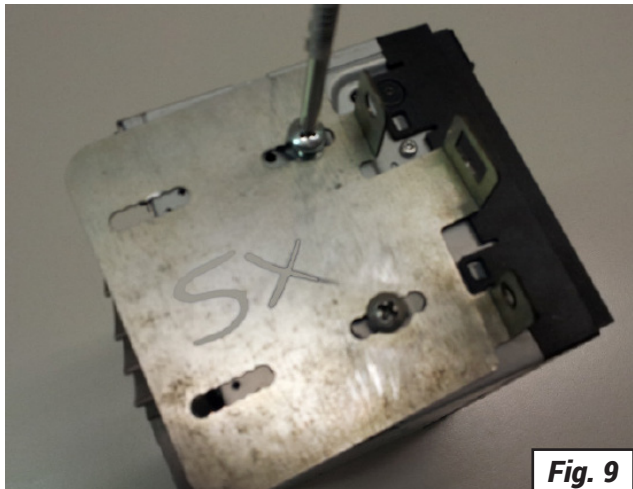

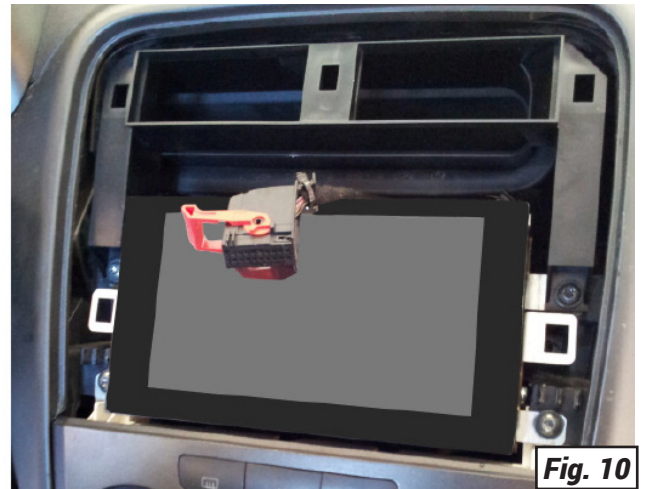
